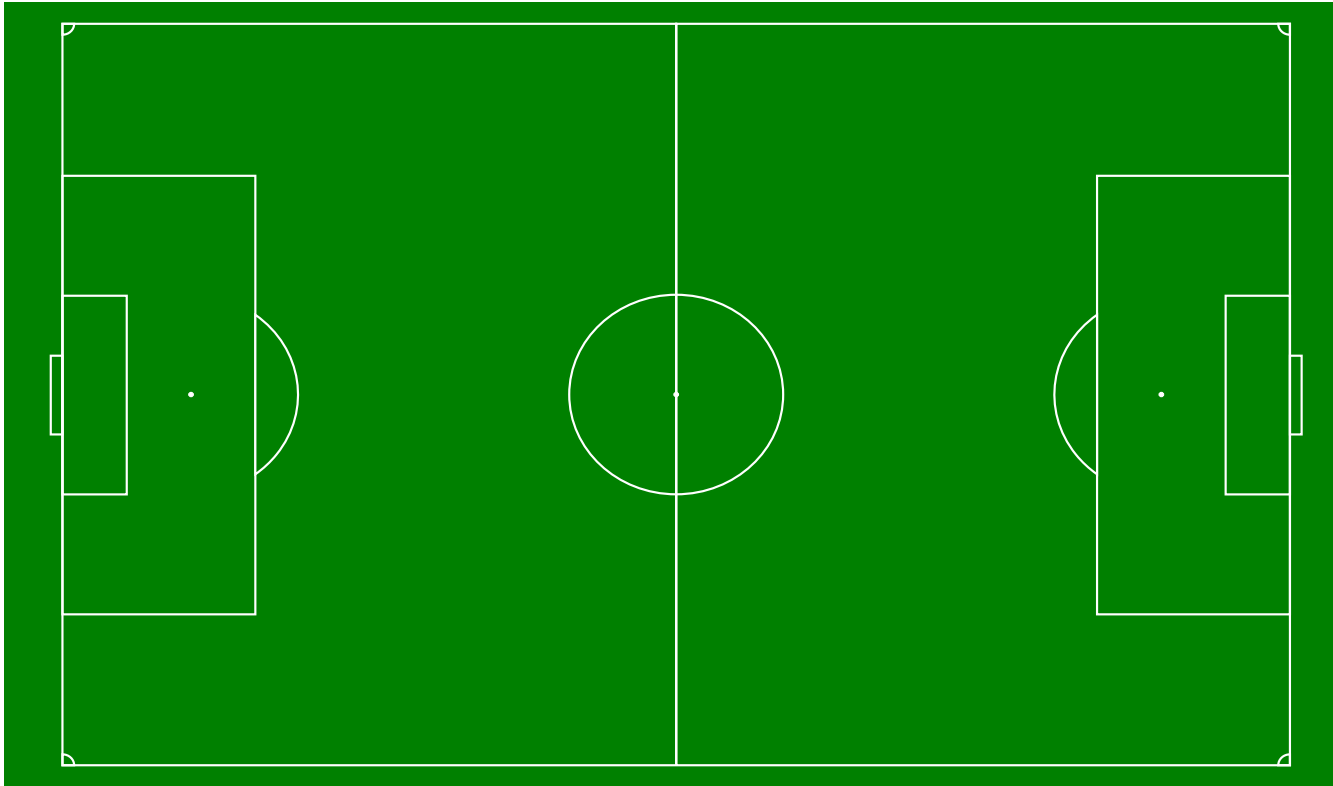

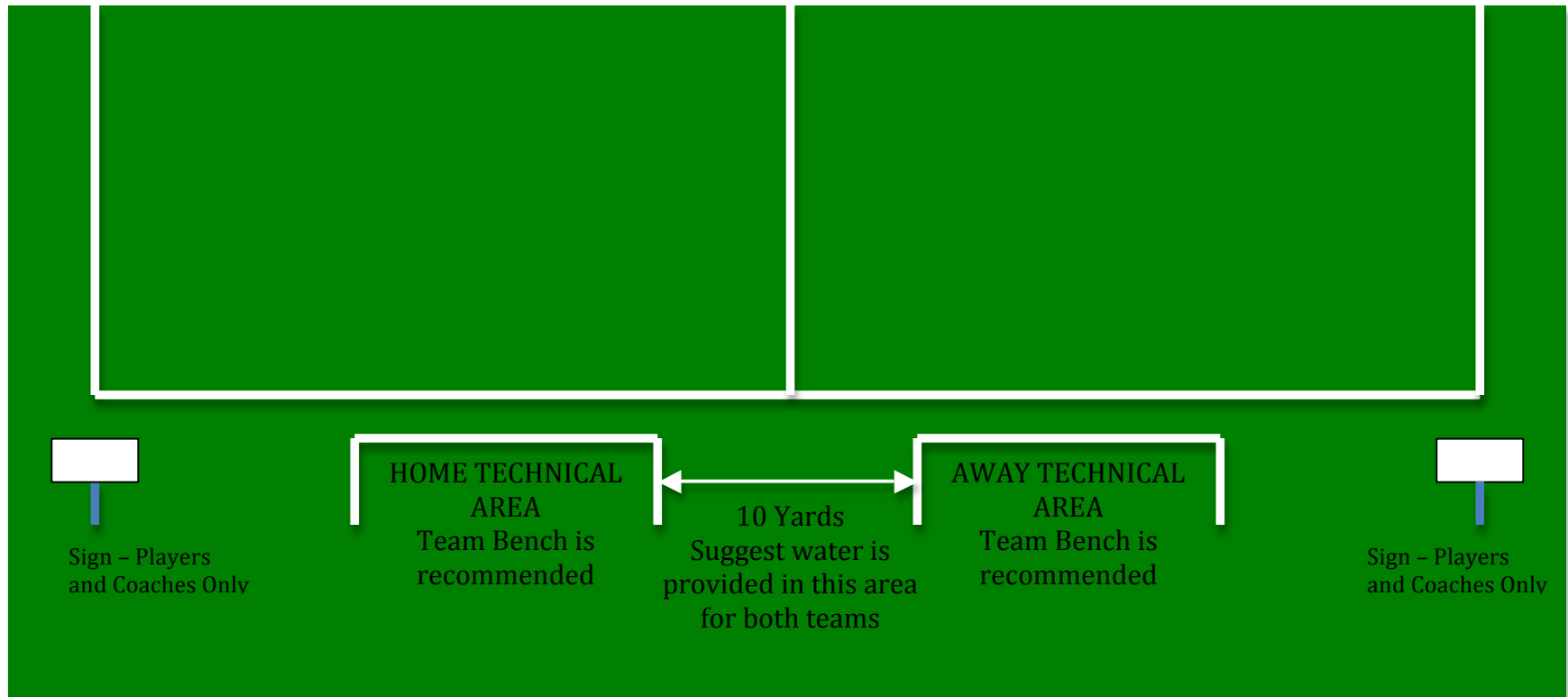

FIELD SETUP INSTRUCTIONS



FIELD SETUP INSTRUCTIONS:

- Home and away team spectators should sit directly across from their team's technical area on the opposite side of the field.
- Parents should not visit the technical area before, during or after the game as this area is reserved for players and coaches only.
- When possible, the spectator area should be designated with a line 2-3 yards parallel to the sideline. Home and away spectator area should be separated with one or two perpendicular lines to the sideline and identified with an H for home and A for away.
- When possible, the two technical areas should be placed 10 yards apart at the midfield. Water may be supplied by the home team if possible. Benches for both teams should be supplied by the home if resources are available.
- It is recommended that signage be placed on either end of both technical areas indicating that this area is for players and coaches only.
- Corner flags should be supplied by the home team and nets/goals should be secured.
